New Beginnings: Uprooting and Planting

Many years ago, as far back as 2005, because of internal challenges, and people not seeing or being willing to follow the vision God gave me for Compassion, I began praying for God to take out of His ministry that which offends, and send in that which would glorify Him.



After a few people leaving and being replaced by others, Franer Malbranche who was serving as the pastor for Compassion of Deliverance Church in Haiti exited the ministry taking the entire church population with him, leaving the compound with an empty church building. I was stunned and shocked to see that God would actually take out the entire church, but I am resolved to trust God's sovereignty, knowing that He knows better than me what does or does not glorify Him in His ministry.

God also caused me to stumble upon and spoke to me through Haggai 2:4 & 9, to encourage and strengthen me in His work, but I need you to know that the transition is still most difficult and we solicit your prayers and support in this new season of planting anew. May God continue to use you that He will be glorified in Haiti through Compassion of Christ. (Isaiah 61:3)



While pressing through this trial, it became clear to me that God was in both teams He recently sent in to reinforce His ministry and His missionary.

Dr. Sabrina Black of Global Projects, came in with a team of 8 to do children's ministry and a Sister to Sister ministry which served over 80 women. The number 8

means new beginnings and I know it's no coincidence that God sent 8 churches with the first team and 8 people with the second. I await with expectation of the new beginning He has in mind for Compassion.

Abundant and Overflowing

I was in awe of my Father - Jehovah Jireh - with this past years Caribbean Christmas Child Project 2012. He opened the windows of Heaven and poured out more than "we could ship in for Christmas".

With the abundant overflow, we were able to give gifts to the 140 Compassion school children, gifts packs to 75 C.H.O. orphanage children and a neighboring Tent City of fifty families. As God provides funds to ship the rest, we will be even more of a blessing to even more.
